1. What is your current practice in psychology? I work as a Behavioral Medicine Specialist at La Clinica de La Raza in Pleasant Hill and Vallejo. This is a primary care clinic. I provide brief interventions and referrals for patients

For 20 years, Dr. Levenson was Director of the Brief Therapy Program at the San Francisco VA Medical Center.

Since 1991, Dr. Levenson has taught brief therapy at California Pacific Medical Center. In 2004, Dr. Levenson joined the core faculty at the Wright Institute in Berkeley. She also maintains a private practice in Oakland and San Francisco, where she sees couples and individuals. Dr. Levenson is a certified therapist and supervisor in Emotionally Focused Couple Therapy (EFT). Through the Levenson Institute for Training (LIFT), she provides in-depth training in integrative, focused therapy for therapists.

Dr. Levenson's special areas of expertise are on attachment theory and brief dynamic, emotionally-focused, relational psychotherapy. She is the author of over 75 chapters and papers, and three books, including the <u>Concise Guide to Brief Dynamic and Interpersonal Psychotherapy</u> (American Psychiatric Press, 2002), and <u>Time-Limited Dynamic Psychotherapy</u>: A <u>Guide to Clinical Practice</u> (Basic Books,1995; Spanish edition, 1997). Her forthcoming book, Brief Dynamic Therapy, is part of the American Psychological Association's (APA) Expert Therapists-Theories of Psychotherapy Series.
